1. SUMMARY REPORT

IHO S8 Category "B" Marine Geospatial Information Programme sponsored by the Republic of Korea will be delivered in a 3-year cycle, and a total of 8 participants, including 4 participants sponsored by the IHO Capacity Building Fund and additional 4 participants supported by ROK, have completed Phase 3.

Phase 3 of a Marine Geospatial Information Program which is one of the 2017 IHO Capacity Building programmes was taken place at Korea Hydrographic and Oceanographic Agency (KHOA), Busan, ROK, from 3 July to 28 July.

Participants taking part in Phase 3 learned marine environment physical & legal issues, remote sensing for hydrographers, raster chart production with practical exercises. They also understood how to use tools and the contents of software for chart production through practical exercises based not only on paper charts but on digital charts. In this way, they were trained to understand and visualize Electronic Navigation Charts and developed their ability to use basic GIS software.

2. VENUE, DATES AND PARTICIPANTS

The course was taken place at the training room of KHOA, 3^{rd} July -28^{th} July 2017. 8 participants attended the course, including 4 trainees from support of IHO CB, and 4 trainees from additional support from ROK. The list of participants appears as Annex 1.
