1. REFERENCE

a. EAHC Circular Letter No. 8/2019 2 July 2019 about Invitation to EAHC Maritime Safety Information (MSI) Course and Management of MSI Database Workshop.

2. OBJECTIVES

The aim of the course is to develop perspective among the participants in the fundamental issues of Maritime Safety Information. The development of such a perspective will be facilitated by overviews, lectures, hands-on, and discussions on the fundamental concept and relevant aspects of Maritime Information. Initially this activity was begun based on EAHC organization cooperation, where Indonesia become one of the member states, and as member states contribution in enhancing capacity and capability in the East Asia regional and NAVAREA XI countries.

3. VENUE, DATES AND PARTICIPANTS

The course was held in Mercure Ancol Hotel, Jakarta Indonesia from 09 – 13 July 2018, in Pulau Seribu room. Total participants were 26, consists of all representative from EAHC member states (9 Indonesian from Pushidrosal and Indonesian DGST). There were 4 instructors (2 from NGA, 2 from Japan and 1 from Indonesia). All EAHC member states have participated by sending delegations, except Democratic People's Republic of Korea and Singapore. As part of NAVAREA XI, Vietnam, Palau and Republic of Marshal Islands also send participant. List of participants and instructors are attached on ANNEX 1. The accommodation, airfare ticket and meals were provided for 4 instructors and 10 participants who were funded by CBSC/IHO. Additional participants consists of Pushidrosal (3 participants), Indonesian DGST (6 participants), 1 additional participant from Republic of Korea and 1 participant from China were covered by their government.

4. COURSE CONTENT

The training course was opened by Indonesian Chief Hydrographer, Rear Admiral Dr. Harjo Susmoro. As part of IHO capacity building program, he said that Pushidrosal as a national hydrographic institution and a member states of EAHC and through course conducted by Pushidrosal, is expected to be able to increase awareness of the importance of maritime information. The information in MSI is very useful in reducing the rate of ship accidents at sea, reducing the level of environmental pollution, thereby increasing trust in the country being navigated. Some information that can be conveyed through MSI includes changes Light of List, shoal, ship accidents, oil spills, military activities, etc. This needs to be broadcast to sailor for know every incident, and to careful when they sailing at the sea.

The MSI course is divided into two activities namely the delivery of theory and sharing of experience and practice of plotting on the charts, wrote the navigational information and the deliver information to the NAVAREA Coordinator in accordance with the standard format in IHO publication S-53. The workshop was divided into two activities which are provisioning theory and practical exercise in classroom and visiting Port of Tanjung Priok VTS facilities and Jakarta coastal radio stations.

The course days delivered. Causes, mechanisms, and impacts of; were presented during lecturing. Course activities are closed by Director of Security Cooperation and Maritime Boundary Pushidrosal, Captain Yanuar Handwiono, which stated in his speech that the course activities carried out are expected to be the provision of the course participants to be applied in their respective countries. Apart from class activities, on Wednesday (11 September 2019) night, organizing committee provided city tour programs by visiting shopping center in the North Jakarta "Mall Kelapa Gading", the biggest shopping center on the Jakarta.

5. SYLLABUS OF PROGRAMME

Syllabus of programme is attached on ANNEX 2.

6. FINANCE REPORT

As per previous submission to IHB, most expenditures were charged to CBSC/IHB in amount of 47,437.22 Euros and the other expenses which not covered by IHB were Pushidrosal responsibility. The finance report to IHB shows only the detailed expenses of that 47,437.22 Euros subject to reimbursement by CBSC/IHO. The airline tickets of participants and instructors had been reimbursed by Pushidrosal. Invoices and receipts are attached on ANNEX 4. The other expenses which will be submitted are accommodation fee for 16 person (participants and 5 instructors); 5 instructors allowances. Accommodations were included hotel room, meal and full board meeting package (lunch and dinner). Remaining participants and other expenditures were funded by Pushidrosal.

7. TRAINING EVALUATION BY QUESTIONNAIRE

Training evaluation was conducted at the end of the course by delivering questionnaire to get feedbacks from participants on some matters including: course contents, course domestic, trainers, and personal outcome. The evaluation would be become our input; hence improvements are able to be made in the future, from 21 student's almost all student gave excellent and very good scores almost in all aspects in the list of questionnaire, several questionnaires such as organizing commitee, preparation of training materials, professionalism of the instructors and the relevance of teaching materials to the field of assignment of the trainees. Questionnaires table lists are attached on ANNEX 7.

8. CONCLUSION

The training course and workshop had been done successfully and every session was delivered by the instructors interestingly. During the course, most of the participants engages in the class discussion productively. Some participants opined that the duration of the training needs to be extended to get all the materials to be understood clearly. However, most of the participants have sufficient knowledge to be developed further, in support their hydrographic office or agency in deliver of maritime information in ensuring the safety of navigation.


