- 1. E-mail in the reference (a) invited MBSHC Members to review their respective CB requirements for the years 2019-2020-2021 and submit them with their comments to the MBSHC CB Coordinator. The reference (b) reported the first results of the questionary. - **e. Technical visits:** There are two Technical Visit requests as a follow-up by Georgia and Lebanon. Technical visit to Georgia has already been planned in 2018. Technical visit to Lebanon will be coordinated and decided with MBSHC Chair.
- 4. The results of the questionary are noted and CB requirements for the short courses for the years 2019-2020-2021 will be planned and submitted annually to the CBSC. CBSC will be informed regarding the requirements for the long courses in the next meeting. Long courses may also be a co-operation issue in the MBSHC Region.
- 5. If CBSC approves the CB Activities planned to be held in 2018, requests of Slovenia, Italy, Tunisia and Lebanon will be considered according to approved budget.
