### Subject: CSPCWG6 Actions 19-20 – Small craft (leisure) symbols

Item 8.6 discussed at the 6<sup>th</sup> CPSCWG meeting was about the use of Small Craft (or Leisure) symbols. The following record of the discussion was made:

#### **CSPCWG6 - 8.6 Small craft (leisure) symbols (UK)**

*Docs: CSPCWG6-08.6A Small Craft (Leisure) Symbols*

The meeting decided that the following 'leisure' symbols should be transferred to INT1 section F: U1.1 (Boat Harbour, Marina); U1.2 (Yacht berths without facilities); U2 (Visitors' berth); U3 (Visitors' mooring); U4 (Yacht club, Sailing Club). The symbols for Caravan and Camping sites should be included as black symbols in INT1 section E (as these may be useful as landmarks; the user would expect there to be seasonal variations and this need not be shown on the charts). All other entries in existing Section U should not be included as INT symbols; the retention of Section U and any symbols are a national option. It was also considered that the 'Mariner facilities box' at U32 is redundant as difficult to maintain and up to date information is generally readily available to the user via internet websites. This finishes the review of small craft symbols at Work Plan item E.5.

**ACTION 19: Secretary** to draft amendment to S-4 for 'leisure' symbols.

**ACTION 20: INT1 subWG** to decide the appropriate location and colour of retained 'leisure' symbols in INT1.

Subsequently, the INT1 subWG has corresponded on the matter, as it makes sense to decide the locations in INT1 and S-4 at the same time. As its Secretary, please see the INT1 subWG's recommendations at

**CSPCWG ACTIONS 19–20 – Small craft (leisure) symbols****Proposals for S-4**

For an explanation of the chosen INT1 numbers, see below. The proposed sizes for the symbols are chosen to be consistent with existing similar symbols.

**B-320.1** already covers boat harbours and marinas. The INT1 reference would need changing to F11.1. The specification would then be expanded to include yacht berths without facilities and yacht clubs. Add:

Yacht berths without facilities must be shown, if required, by the magenta symbol (diameter about 3.5mm):

 **F11.2**

A yacht club or sailing club must be shown, if required, by the magenta symbol (height about 3mm):

 **F11.3**

**B-323** already exists for berths. Add:

**B323.2 A visitors' berth** (for example in a marina) must be shown by the magenta symbol (diameter about 2.5mm):

 **F19.2**

Existing B-323.2 (names of quays, piers, etc) would be renumbered B-323.3.

**B-431.5:** Add, immediately after Q40:

**A visitors' mooring** (for example in a marina) must be shown by the symbol (height about 3mm):

 **Q45**

It is considered by the INT1 subWG that one symbol (a small black caravan) is sufficient to cover camping sites as well as caravan sites. In many cases, tents and caravans are located together and caravans are likely to be much more visible than tents. The INT1subWG considers that the most suitable place to include specifications for caravan/camping sites in S-4 is:

**B-368 CARAVAN AND CAMPING SITES**

Caravan and camping sites should only be charted if they are likely to be visible from seaward, when they may provide useful identification features.

A caravan and/or camping site must be shown, if required, by the symbol (height about 3mm):

 **E37**

If it is useful to show the extent of the site, the symbols may be shown within a black dashed line. The chart user will understand that in some areas such sites may be seasonal (especially camping sites), so there is no need to include a note or legend stating that fact.

**Proposals for INT1**

**U1.1, U1.2 and U4** to become **F11.1, F11.2 and F11.3** respectively. (Note: It does not appear that there has ever been an F11).

**U2** add to **F19**. Split F19 into:

19.1 Designation of berth

19.2 Visitors' berth

**U3** move to **Q45** (section for moorings and mooring buoys). The symbol (which is for a physical mooring buoy) should be changed to black.

**U29** move to **E37** (colour changed to black).
