Please send or bring your poster to Royale Chulan hotel by Sunday afternoon, 04 Oct. Lt. Cdr. Shaiful RMN will collect posters Sunday afternoon to put them on display at the Convention Centre. If you cannot get them to the hotel by this deadline, there will be a small amount of time between 0800 and 0830 to setup posters.

We will need the hard copy of your poster for display. We will not the capability to print out posters at the meeting site.

6. Poster Take-Down:

All poster presenters are invited to leave their posters on display until the end of Science Day. The posters can be disposed for you if you do not wish to take them home. If you want them back and are unable to retrieve them at the end of Science Day, please let me know, and I will see what we can do to have your poster returned if you have a pre-paid courier label and container for the poster.

If you can send electronic copies (in PDF) to me and Pauline Weatherall as provided for in the Call for Papers anytime before the meeting, we can put your poster on the GEBCO web site if you like to do so. Optionally, you can put them on a cloud sharing site, such as Google Drive, and let us know the link to download them. We also can put them on the web site after the meeting as well. If you do not want your talk on the web site (for example, you intend to submit the material to a peer-reviewed journal for publication), that is fine too.
