## **ENC PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION STATUS**

## FRANCE (July 2005)

With 158 ENCs produced, SHOM has covered nearly 90% of national merchant and passengers navigation routes. If priority has been initially given to commercial sea lanes and environmental sensitive areas in metropolitan France (i.e. in the Channel, the Atlantic coast and the Mediterranean sea), SHOM has started in 2005 production of ENCs corresponding to INT paper charts attributed through Regional Hydrographic Commissions and in French overseas territories:

- ENCs are already available in Bab El Mandeb strait, in the regions of Djibouti and Dakar; small scale ENCs covering Mozambic channel and West Africa will also be distributed this year;
- ENCs covering La Réunion are now also available and coverage of French Caribbean Islands and French Guyana will be completed in 2006.

Coverage in metropolitan France will also of course be progressively completed to meet fishing and pleasure crafts needs: all of this meaning around 100 new French ENCs until end of 2007.

The encoding of 62 ENCs has been outsourced with CARIS and IIC companies in 2004 and 2005. Final verification of the data, weekly updating of ENCs (ER) and new editions are done in-house at SHOM.

All the ENC production processes are ISO9001: 2000 certified.

All SHOM ENCs (including ER) are distributed encrypted via PRIMAR-STAVANGER. There are 158 ENCs available in usage band general (4), coastal (56), approach (53), harbour (33), and berthing (12).
