Reference: 5th HSSC Meeting (Shanghai, China, 5-8 November 2013)

1. Objective

To revise IHO Publication S-66 – "Facts about electronic charts and carriage requirements".

2. Authority

This Project Team is a subsidiary of the HSSC established in accordance with the consolidated HSSC Work Plan 2014-2015 (paragraph 14, work item B1).

3. Composition and Chairmanship

- a) The Project Team shall comprise representatives of the RENCs, representatives of voluntary IHO Member States (MS) and a representative of the IHB. A membership list shall be maintained and posted on the IHO website.
- b) The Chair is the representative of IC-ENC.
- c) If a secretary is required it should normally be drawn from a member of the Project Team.
- d) Expert Contributors may be invited to participate by the Chair.

4. Procedures

- a) The Project Team should work primarily by correspondence and teleconferences, although face to face meetings at the project start, and at other significant milestones, may be convenient when held in conjunction with another convenient IHO forum.
- b) Decisions should be made by consensus. Dissenting opinions if any should be reflected in the Project Team report.
- c) The Project Team should liaise with other IHO bodies, international organizations and industry, as appropriate, to ensure the relevance of its work.
- d) The Project Team shall report to the 6th meeting of HSSC.
