Dear Sir or Madam,

This letter provides information on the current status of various CHRIS-related issues and proposes a draft agenda for the next, 15<sup>th</sup> CHRIS Meeting to be held at the IHB on 10-13 June 2003.

- <u>CHRIS Vice-Chair</u> CHRIS Letter 9/2002 asked for nominations for the position of Vice-Chair of CHRIS. Whereas there were no volunteering candidates, the name of Cdr **Robert Ward**, Australia, was proposed by several CHRIS members. I am most pleased to report that Robert Ward has received the necessary support from his hierarchy and has therefore kindly accepted to take the position of CHRIS Vice-Chair. On this occasion, CHRIS Membership was also confirmed and the result is at **Annex A**.
- 2. <u>CSPCWG</u> Circular Letter 51/2002 asked for candidates to fill the positions of Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary of the newly formed Chart Standardization and Paper Chart Working Group, which has replaced the former IHO Chart Standardization Committee (CSC). Member States were also asked to confirm their participation in this WG. The resulting membership of CSPCWG is shown in the table at **Annex B**. I am pleased to report that CSPCWG Officers' positions have been filled as follows:

Telephone: (+377) 93.10.81.00 Telefax: (+377) 93.10.81.40 e-mail: info@ihb.mc WEB: www.iho.shom.fr The new Chair of CSPCWG is kindly requested to organise and commence work, based on the Terms of Reference for the WG (see Annex A to CL 51/2002), the CSPCWG Report to CHRIS-14 (Doc. CHRIS-14-7.5A Rev.1, available from the CHRIS section of the IHO website <a href="https://www.iho.shom.fr/general/ecdis/ecdisnew1.html">www.iho.shom.fr/general/ecdis/ecdisnew1.html</a>), and the IHO Work Programme (see CL 41/2002).

As a result, the table showing the membership of CHRIS-related WGs has been updated and is at **Annex C**. Please report to the Secretary (pac@ihb.mc) any changes to this table.

3. <u>IHO Website</u> - A CHRIS sub-working group was formed at the 14<sup>th</sup> CHRIS meeting in Shanghai tasked with improving CHRIS communication to its members. This working group lead by New Zealand determined at that meeting that the IHO web site should become a principle method of providing CHRIS information to its members. The recommendation was accepted by the meeting. The sub-working group was then tasked with an evaluation of the IHO web site to determine how this could be better utilised to improve CHRIS communication to its members.

The work of this sub WG has resulted in the production of the following three documents (available from the CHRIS section of the IHO website), that describe how the IHO website should be reorganised and developed to provide improved communication, not just for CHRIS but for all IHO committees and working groups:

- Review principles Principles used for the review of the website.
- **Publishing Guidelines** Website best practice and proposed templates.
- Web Site mock up A mock up of what the new site would look like.

The above documents have been used as a basis by the IHB in re-designing the IHO website. This is acknowledged in CL 18/2003 where it is said: "Although these documents only became available after work on the new website had commenced, they have been used as guidance documents and will continue to provide the framework for further development. The IHB is thankful for the excellent work done by the CHRIS advisory group".

On behalf of CHRIS I wish to thank the sub-working group, and in particular its Chair, Mr **Michael Farrell**, New Zealand, for the efforts in producing the proposal for improvements of the IHO website and a job very well done.

- 4. <u>Changes to IHO Standards</u> CL 54/2002 requested Member States to approve that the 'Principles and a Set of Procedures for making Changes to IHO Standards', as agreed by CHRIS, be made a new IHO Technical Resolution (TR A1.20). Although a large majority of the respondents supported the proposal, i.e. 25 out of 28 replies (see interim summary of responses at **Annex D**), this is not enough for this proposal to be adopted, according to Article VI, Paragraph 6 of the IHO Convention which requires a simple majority of the total number of Member States, i.e. 36 positive votes are necessary. As a result, those CHRIS Members whose HOs have not yet replied to Annex C to CL 54/2002, are urged to act accordingly.
- 5. <u>ENC Security Scheme</u> Member States were requested via CL 44/2002 to approve Version 1 of the IHO Security Scheme for ENC, based on the Primar scheme, to agree that the role of Security Scheme Administrator be transferred to the IHB, and to support that the development of Version 2 of the IHO Security Scheme be initiated as soon as feasible. All three proposals were approved, as reflected in CL 66/2002, and are being implemented through a meeting of the Data Protection Scheme Advisory Group (DPSAG), on 13-14 March 2003, and a training session for IHB personnel, scheduled on 23-25 April, both at the IHB, Monaco.
- 6. <u>Actions arising from CHRIS-14</u> The status of all actions arising from CHRIS-14, as known to the Secretary, is shown at **Annex E** Most of the actions on the IHB have been completed. Those

CHRIS members concerned with the remaining actions are kindly requested to take action as necessary and report on their status to the Chair/Secretary.

- 7. <u>Draft Agenda for CHRIS-15</u> A provisional agenda for the 15<sup>th</sup> CHRIS Meeting is proposed at **Annex F**.
- 8. <u>Submission deadline for Documents</u> Documents intended for consideration at the meeting, i.e. Reports from WGs' Chairs and any new items should be submitted to the Secretary before 10 May, i.e. one month in advance of the meeting. All documents will be placed on the IHO website as and when they are received. <u>Documents arriving after this deadline will be treated as information documents only.</u>
- 9. I intend to break the meeting into smaller groups in the same way as during CHRIS 14 to progress certain items of work, following initial discussions of the principles in plenary. No discussions will take place in plenary during such a phase. Currently, I can foresee at least two items which might require such treatment. One relates to the work of CHRIS and the formulation of guidelines concerning the submission of proposals to CHRIS and guidelines on setting work program priorities. The other relates to liaison with industry, where we might have an opportunity to provide input into SPWG.
- 10. I have included an extra day in the time available to us for this purpose.

I am looking forward to seeing you all in Monaco.
