Dear Colleagues,

This letter provides information on the current status of actions arising from the 16th CHRIS Meeting (Ottawa, Canada, 28-31 May 2004); it further proposes a draft agenda for the 17th CHRIS Meeting, 5-9 September 2005, and a provisional programme for the ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum (formerly "Industry Days"), 6-7 September 2005, both to be held at the German Hydrographic Service (BSH) in Rostock. A CHRIS Chair Group meeting, comprising all chairmen of WGs and sub-WGs will also be held on 4 September. Practical information on these events will be provided at a later date.

- 1. Actions arising from CHRIS/16 The status of all actions arising from CHRIS/16 was described in Annex A to CL 22/2005, showing that most of the actions for the IHB have been completed. A number of actions are however still pending; they have been summarized in **Annex C**. Those CHRIS members concerned with the remaining actions are kindly requested to take action as necessary and report on their status to the Chairman / Secretary.
- 2. <u>Draft Agenda for CHRIS/17</u> A provisional agenda for the 17th CHRIS Meeting is proposed at **Annex A.** Associated documents have also tentatively been listed. CHRIS Members are kindly requested to review this draft and provide any comments / new agenda items to the Secretary (mhuet@ihb.mc), copy to the Chairman (robert.ward@hydro.gov.au), **before 29 June 2005**.
- 3. <u>Submission deadline for Documents</u> Documents intended for consideration at the meeting, e.g. Reports from WG Chairs, proposals for new work programme items etc. should be submitted to the Secretary by 15th July 2005, i.e. 7 weeks in advance of the meeting, in accordance with the "Guidelines for the Submission of Reports and Proposals for Consideration by CHRIS and CHRIS Subsidiary Bodies" (see

<u>www.iho.shom.fr</u> > Committees > CHRIS). All documents will be placed on the IHO website as and when they are received.

Those Member States, who wish to submit alternative proposals or make substantial amendments to a proposal, or who wish to make comments *in absentia* on documents posted prior to 15 July, should do so **no later than 12 August**, i.e. 3 weeks before the commencement of the meeting, and their submission should contain a maximum of 4 pages. Documents received after 12 August will be treated as information documents only.

- 4. I intend to break the meeting into smaller groups in the same way as during CHRIS/16 to progress certain items of work, following initial discussions of the principles in plenary. No discussions will take place in plenary during such a phase.
- 5. <u>ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum</u> A provisional programme is proposed at **Annex B** I proposed this important meeting on ECDIS standards and the impact on "industry" in my recent letter to the IHB **(Annexe D)** published under cover of IHO CL26/2005. CHRIS Members and ECDIS Stakeholders (to whom this letter is copied) are kindly requested to review my letter and the draft agenda for the forum and provide any comments to the Secretary (mhuet@ihb.mc), copy to the Chairman (robert.ward@hydro.gov.au), **before 29 June 2005**.

I thank Germany for offering to host the 17th CHRIS Meeting and the ECDIS Stakeholders' Forum.

I am looking forward to seeing you all in Rostock.

Dear Admiral Maratos,

As Chairman of the IHO Committee on Hydrographic Requirements for Information Systems (CHRIS), it has been brought to my attention that there is concern about the development of S-57e4.0 as an updated hydrographic data transfer standard, its possible impact on the production and implementation of S57e3.1 ENCs, and on associated ECDIS software. This is as a result of the information paper posted on the IHO website titled: "The Next Edition of IHO S57 (4.0)" (as reported in CL 83/2004 dated 7 December 2004, and posted at: http://www.iho.shom.fr/ECDIS/S-57_Ed4_Information_Paper.pdf) and more recently in statements contained in IHO C/L 22/2005.

The CHRIS is very aware of the significant investment and dependence that IHO M/S, ECDIS manufacturers, ENC production software developers and many others have on the current edition of the S57e3.1 ENC Product Specification (Prod Spec). For this reason, the S-57e3.1 ENC Prod Spec cannot be cancelled or replaced without very careful consideration. No decision has been made to supersede the S-57e3.1 ENC prod spec with an S-57e4.0 ENC Prod Spec. So far, the only Prod Spec that has been endorsed for future development is for bathymetric/hydrographic data (see IHO C/L 18/99). However, little work has been done on this. In any case, neither this nor the development of S-57e4.0 will impact on current ENC production, ENC distribution, ECDIS manufacture or ECDIS usage.

Of course, the CHRIS needs to look to the future and ensure that the IHO's technical standards remain relevant and appropriate. It is in this context that discussion has commenced on the long-term future of the S-57e3.1 Prod Spec. In doing so, the CHRIS believes that full consultation with and consideration of the views from those potentially affected by any proposed changes to IHO technical standards and guidelines are critically important to the process.

In accordance with this principle, the TSMAD WG are setting up a discussion group dedicated to the topic of the future of the S57 ENC Prod Spec. It will be available through the IHO website at www.iho.shom.fr – via Committees? CHRIS? TSMAD SubWG to encourage debate over the long term future of the ENC Prod Spec and to identify all the issues.

In addition to this, I intend to follow up on this discussion by holding an "ECDIS Stakeholders Forum" in conjunction with the next CHRIS meeting. The ECDIS Stakeholders

Forum will take place in Rostock, Germany on 6-7 September 2005. The following questions will need to be answered:

- Should the S-57e3.1 Prod Spec stay frozen indefinitely?
- What are the important limitations of the s-57e3.1 Prod Spec?
- Are these limitations sufficiently serious that an upgrade/improvement program is necessary?
- If so, how can an upgrade/improvement program be achieved with the minimum impact on all concerned?

The Stakeholders Forum will be open to all parties that have an interest or involvement in ECDIS and ECDIS chart data. The results from the Forum will then be considered by CHRIS in the Meeting that follows immediately. As such, the Forum will be a significant opportunity for all "ECDIS stakeholders" to enlighten the CHRIS and influence the future direction of ECDIS and ENC standards.

In the meantime, I stress once again, that there are <u>No</u> current plans to supersede or replace the current S57e3.1 ENC Product Specification. Furthermore, no significant changes will take place without wide consultation with all the parties likely to be affected by any changes. I seek your assistance in promulgating this statement as widely as possible. Furthermore, I encourage all readers to consider the issues surrounding the S57 ENC Product Specification and to contribute to the forthcoming discussions both on the WWW and in Rostock.
