Dear Colleagues,

This letter provides information on the current status of actions arising from the 15<sup>th</sup> CHRIS Meeting (IHB, Monaco, 10-13 June 2003) and proposes a draft agenda for the 16<sup>th</sup> CHRIS Meeting to be held at the Canadian Hydrographic Service, Ottawa, on 28-31 May 2004. - 3. <u>Submission deadline for Documents</u> Documents intended for consideration at the meeting, e.g. Reports from WG Chairs, proposals for new work programme items etc. should be submitted to the Secretary by the same date, in accordance with the "Instructions for submission of proposals to CHRIS and CHRIS subsidiary bodies" adopted at CHRIS/15 (see Minutes of CHRIS/15, Annex G). All documents will be placed on the IHO website as and when they are received.

Those Member States, who wish to submit alternative proposals or make substantial amendments to a proposal, or who wish to make comments *in absentia* on documents posted prior to 7 April, should do so no later than 6 May, i.e. 3 weeks before the commencement of the meeting, and their submission should contain a maximum of 4 pages. <u>Documents received after 6 May will be treated as information documents only</u>.
