


Fig.1 Index map showing the location of the Weiyu Guyot




Fig.2 Bathymetric map of the Weiyu Guyot (Contours are in 200m).




Fig.3 Bathymetric map of the Weiyu Guyot, showing track lines. (Contours are in $200 \mathrm{m}$)




Fig.4 3-D bathymetric map of the Weiyu Guyot.




Fig.5 Profile of the Weiyu Guyot
