


Fig.1 Index map showing the location of the Dacheng Guyot




Fig.2 Bathymetric map of the Dacheng Guyot. (Contours are in 200m)




Fig.3 Bathymetric map of the Dacheng Guyot, showing track lines. (Contours are in 200 m)




Fig.5 Profile of the Dacheng Guyot
