Figure 1. Location of Paeraengi Knoll




Figure 2. Track Line of Paeraengi Knoll Survey Area




Figure 3. 2-D Bathymetric Contour Map of Paeraengi Knoll




Figure 4. Boundary of Paeraengi Knoll with polygon points






Figure 5. 3-D Topographic Map of Paeraengi Knoll








Figure 6. Profiles Across Paeraengi Knoll
