




Fig.2 Bathymetric map of Changjun Seamount (Contours are in 100 m)




Fig.3 Bathymetric map of Changjun Seamount overlain with track lines (Contours are in 100 m, blue lines for the track lines)




Fig.4 3-D bathymetric map of Changjun Seamount




Fig.5 Profile map of Changjun Seamount
