- Report to IHO with proposals for 2012 workshop under the aegis of NRHC with invites to ARHC and BRHC (1st draft by KMS)
- Individual and shared cost-benefit analyses of continued joint work
- Begin to address the shortcomings of the NP1/2/3 approach with IHO

Information

- Examine crowd-sourcing and other resource-savings approaches
- Share best practice surrounding updating techniques
- Revise existing publications – “new” editions with “old” data and removed conflicts
- Share knowledge and experience with open source approaches – possible pilot project
- Follow SNPWG

Users

- Conduct a survey of mariners’ requirements
- Link to private sector data distribution initiatives (ie. aviation iPads)
- Address future developments of platforms for information display
- Make existing publications available through a shared web platform

Short term approach

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- New standards
 - Codification in formal platforms

Information
