Dear Chair of the ARHC,

Finland has participated ARHC meetings as an Observer since 2011. At the ARHC meeting last year in Portsmouth USA it was noted that according the ARHC statues, Finland and Iceland as IHO member states should apply for an Associate Membership instead of acting as an Observer.

Arctic area is important to Finland in many ways and it is already working closely with other Members States in the umbrella of the Arctic Council. Due the northern location of the country, Arctic shipping routes are seen as great opportunities for Finland's maritime transport and foreign trade. The Finnish Transport Agency has quite a lot experience operating in arctic conditions and recognizes the need i.e. to develop hydrographic products and services for ice navigation. Finland believes that a close cooperation with the Arctic Regional Hydrographic Commission and its workgroups e.g. OTWG allows good possibilities to change experiences and knowledge on these areas and serves the interests of all parties.
