Consultation on EU-Policy Marine Knowledge 2020: from seabed mapping to ocean forecasting

1. Public consultation

On 29 August 2012 the European Commission launched a consultation on the Green Paper "Marine Knowledge 2020: from seabed mapping to ocean forecasting" to understand stakeholders' opinions on options for future governance of the EU's "marine knowledge 2020" initiative and on the possible involvement of the private sector.
