


Hydro-Morphologic Survey HARBOR CHART H-7113 "MACKELLAR COVE" a. Location

First Hydrographic-Morphologic Survey with Multibeam technology on board of the AEH-178 hydrographic vessel.



There is not a tide gauge network, however several tide gauges were installed for short periods of time, in the vecinity of Crepin Point which is located near Machu Picchu Scientific Station.










5. OTHER ACTIVITIES

During the Antarctic Expedition, a WATHERPACK Automatic meteorological station was installed on board of BIC Humboldt.





6. ACTIVITIES 2014



The Directorate of Hydrography and Navigation has planned the following activities in 2014:

- ✓ Distribution of National Antarctic nautical charts in paper and electronic format.
- ✓ Conversion of National Antarctic Nautical Charts in the format established for producing international charts (INT) to be sent to IHO HCA.
- ✓ Oceanographic Research cruise in Bransfiel strait.
- ✓ Collection of meteorologic data.
- ✓ Approval of the Public Investment Project to purchase a hydrooceanographic vessel with polar capacity.
