2. Surveys : (a) A Detached Survey Party consisting of one officer and a survey technician visited Antarctica from 02 Jan to 27 Mar 09 as part of

28th Indian Antarctica Expedition (IAE).

(b) The team undertook geodetic control, coastlining and sounding operations at Larsemann Hills and Princess Astrid Coast. A new station 'Blair Point' was set up on the shore of Donovan Promontory for future use as it overlooks the proposed channel at Larsemann Hills.

(c) Sounding operations were conducted using expedition vessel MV Emerald Sea. Due to the prevailing weather sounding was limited to only a few occasions, which too were marred by floating ice. The ship was not designed for survey purpose and hence difficulty was experienced in maneuvering it. Though data has been collected for compiling Chart 9051, there are certain gaps in the area, due to ice cover, which needed to be filled. Attempt was made to cover these gaps. The Indian Naval Hydrographic Department (INHD) expects to depute a team in 2009-10 again to fill these gaps so that Chart 9051 can be completed.
