1. 14th Conference of HCA

The 14th Conference of the IHO Hydrographic Commission on Antarctica (HCA-14) will be hosted by the *Instituto Oceanográfico de la Armada* (INOCAR) and will take place in Guayaquil, Ecuador from 24 to 26 March 2015.

a) Agenda:

A provisional agenda and timetable for the Conference is proposed in Annex A. You are kindly requested to review this draft and to provide your comments and suggestions for changes or improvements **not later than 31 January 2015**.

As in 2014, it is proposed that Invited Industry Contributors will deliver relevant presentations as part of the applicable agenda item. Industry Contributors are therefore requested to contact the Secretary (adcs@iho.int) to coordinate any formal inputs or presentations that they wish to be considered so that they can be included in an appropriate part of the agenda.

b) Venue and Accommodation:

The Conference will take place at the *Hotel Ramada* (www.hotelramada.com, Guayaquil). General and logistics information, such as other available hotels, have been posted on the IHO website www.iho.int > Committees and WGS > HCA > HCA-14. Attendees should book their chosen hotel at their earliest convenience.

c) <u>Registration</u>:

Those who intend to participate in HCA-14 are requested to complete the Registration Form provided in Annex B (also available on the IHO website) and send it via e-mail to: INOCAR — Miss Angela Garcia (angela.garcia@inocar.mil.ec) copy to the HCA Secretary (adcs@iho.int), at their earliest opportunity and **not later than 31 January 2015** to keep our hosts in Ecuador and the IHB well informed of the anticipated number of participants.

2. Actions from HCA-13:

As reported in the reference, the <u>final minutes of the 13th HCA Conference</u> are available from the IHO website. An updated version of the Actions List from HCA-13 providing the current status of the actions is also given at Annex C.

As a reminder and in accordance with Action HCA13/21, HCA Members are requested to provide the IHB, **by 31 January 2015**, with the relevant metadata for past surveys for inclusion into the IHO HCA Antarctic GIS Database (See www.iho.int > Committees and WGS > HCA > Miscellaneous > Antarctica Surveys Metadata).

HCA Members are also informed that the IHO HCA website has been updated with the inclusion of the Tide Tables for Antarctica - October 2014 to December 2015, with the kind permission of the *Servicio de Hidrografico Naval*, Argentina (See www.iho.int > Committees and WGS > HCA > Miscellaneous > Tide Tables...Argentina).

The IHB is continuing to progress the pending issues from HCA-13 related to IHB action. HCA Members and Observers are requested to act on any remaining actions placed on them, as appropriate and in advance of the next Conference.

3. HCA Hydrography Priorities Working Group (HPWG)

HCA-12 decided to transfer the responsibility for coordinating the INT chart and ENC scheming in Region M from the IHB to the Hydrography Priorities Working Group (HPWG). Accordingly, HPWG is now the INT chart & ENC coordinator, in addition to monitoring survey priorities in Antarctic waters. As a result, a half-day has been set aside during the Conference period to discuss specific HPWG issues. This is indicated in the draft conference agenda and timetable.

4. National Reports to HCA-14

HCA Members are reminded that they should provide the HCA Secretary with national reports at least one month in advance of HCA conferences. This means that reports should reach the IHB **not later than 28 February 2015**.
