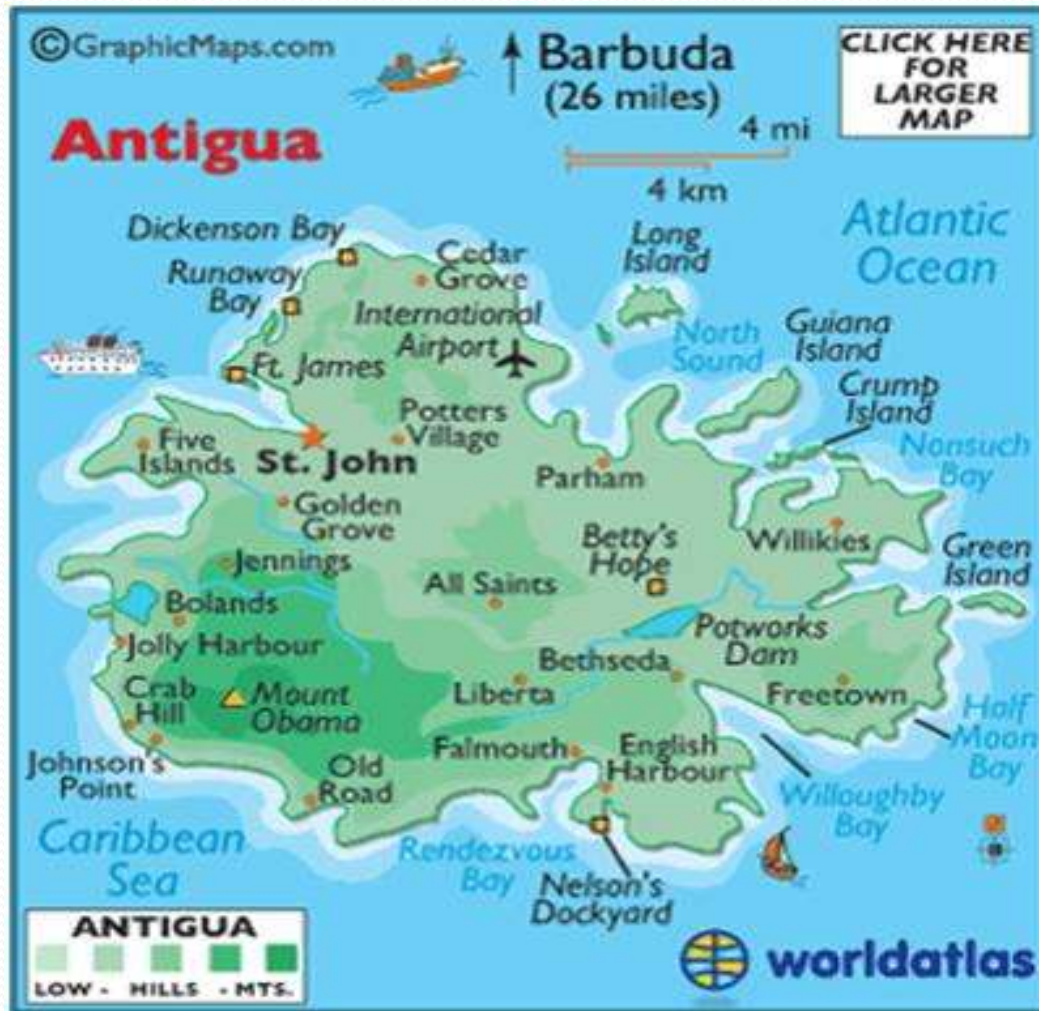

Level 1

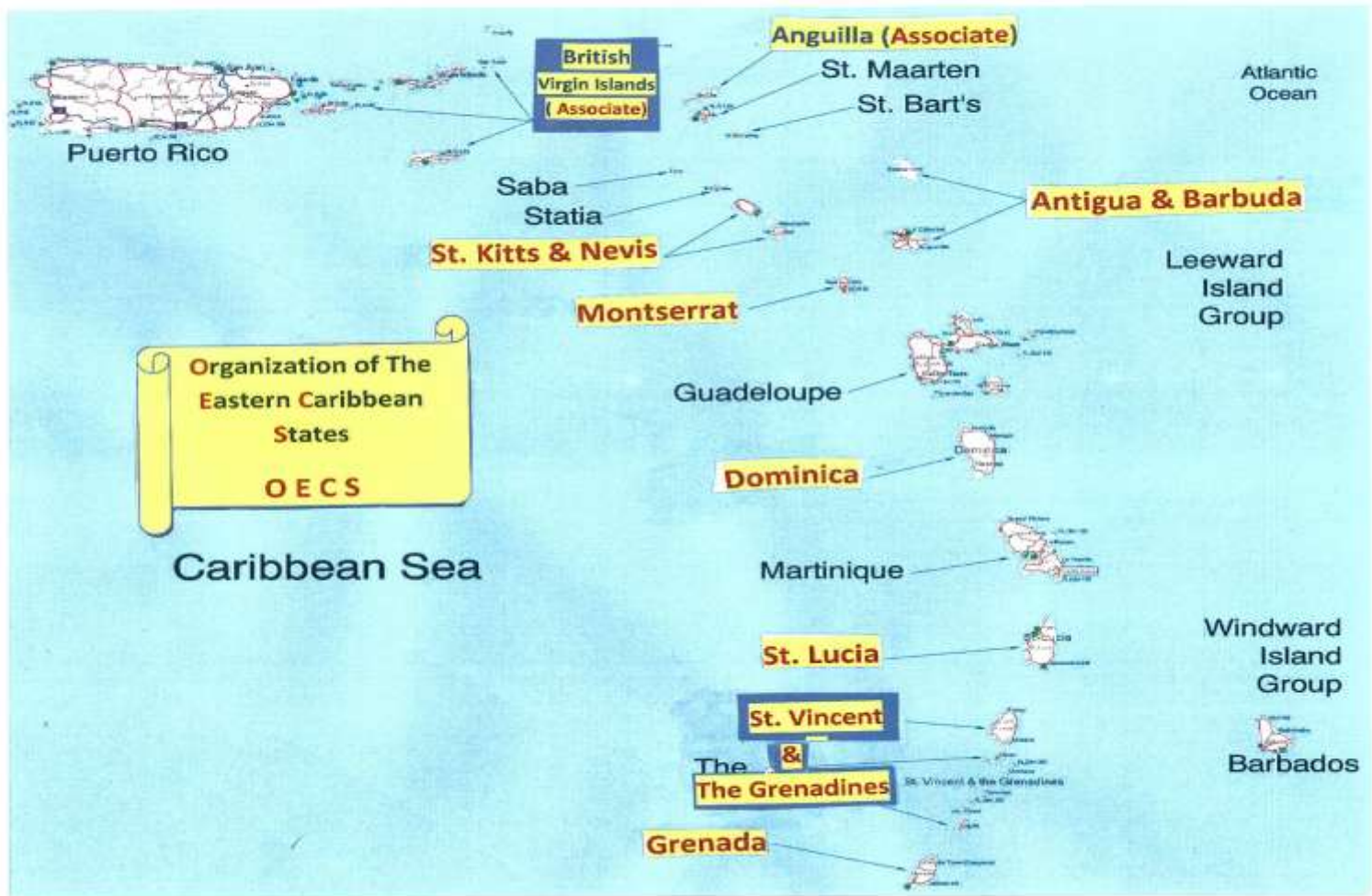
