


DOVER STRAIT SURVEY STRATEGY

NSHC 29th decided:

- a) To discuss the results of the studies presented on the subject (all)
- b) To adopt common dunes characterization criteria (all)
- c) To discuss on areas of responsibility for survey vs. charting (all)
- d) To implement a survey strategy (each nation)

Actions a - b - c: discussed in Brussels meeting.

Action d: in progress. FR wrote its new strategy – surveys following this new strategy will begin in 2013.



Meeting in Brussels 20th January 2011 decided :

- 1. Send current median line co-ordinates to FR by end Jan All
- 2. Produce a draft diagram of the new extents and limits of the Agreement by end Feb FR
- 3. Draft new Agreement by end Jul UK
- 4. Copy letter to NL re survey in B waters to DSSS WG and NSHC Chair end Feb BE
- 5. Data collected in other nation's waters to be exchanged, following agreement on format and medium, by end June All
- 6. Advise the process MCA used to obtain INTERREG funding for the JIBS and INIS Hydro projects by end Feb UK
- 7. Provide the dunes dangerosity criteria to All by end Feb and provide comments under the silence procedure by end Jun All

Actions 1-2: FR thinks that no diagram is neccesary because the area is well defined by the limits of TSS in the IMO « Ships' Routeing » and the national limits (territorial waters and EEZ).



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- Action 3: FR prepared a draft to be discussed (not provided before this NSHC meeting).
- Action 4: copy received (the Flemish Hydrography will survey belgian waters concerned by this agreement): 02/05/2011.
