Dear Hydrographer,

1. The International Hydrographic Organization (IHO) Capacity Building Work Programme has scheduled a 'Ports and Shallow Water Bathymetry Technical Workshop' for the benefit of countries in the South West Pacific. **The workshop will be held in Brisbane, Australia on 13-14 February 2012, to be followed by the 11th SWPHC Conference on 15-16 February 2012.**

2. On behalf of the IHO, Australia as capacity building coordinator for the SWPHC will be responsible coordinating this workshop, in association with the IHB and other SWPHC Member States. The aim of the workshop is "To aid the exchange of information and ideas about the challenges faced by port and shallow water surveyors in the South West Pacific".

The workshop will cover the following topics:

- a) General aspects of port surveying and shallow water bathymetry
- b) Horizontal and Vertical Control
- c) Water Levels and Currents
- d) Hydrographic Survey Specifications and Planning
- e) Instrumentation and methodologies used
- f) Data processing
- g) Hydrographic and cartographic products and services
- h) Nautical Publications
- i) Importance of updating
- j) Technological developments

3. Participants will be invited from the following countries/organisations:

Cook Islands, Fiji, French Polynesia, Kiribati, New Caledonia, Nauru, Niue, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tokelau, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu and SOPAC.

4. The IHO Capacity Building Fund will provide financial support to eligible applicants, i.e. one participant from each of the countries indicated above. This will cover transportation, accommodation and meals.

Applicants must be fully aware of the following conditions which apply to this application:

(i) The workshop is for persons supported by the national authority and committed to work in the hydrography area.

(ii) The workshop will be conducted in English.

(iii) VISA to enter the host country (Australia) is the responsibility of the applicant country.

(iv) There is no money provided directly to participants. The IHB will make the necessary arrangements for transportation (air travel & local transport), accommodation and meals. Any additional costs and any other associated expenses (e.g. insurance, pocket money etc) should be covered by the participant's organization.
