







#### • Nautical Charts

- total of 14 Charts covering the whole of Kiribati,
- published by UKHO at varying scales,
- all except one are referenced to old datum and soundings in fathoms,
- published in the 1950s and 1960s from surveys with data obtained around 1943 and earlier,
- only BA 731 (Gilbert Group) published in 1994.

- Charts requiring immediate improvement
  - Port Betio, Tarawa
  - Butaritari Island
  - English Harbour, Fanning Island
  - Port London, Christmas Island
  - Kanton Island
  - all plans (large scale) in Gilbert group and Washington Island (Line Islands)

- Promulgation of MSI
  - broadcasted locally by Radio Station,
  - sometimes through agents (emails),
  - BUT NOT SENT to PCA (UKHO) or Navarea Coordinator,
- Surveys and new data
  - none have been carried out to update charts,
  - Lands department focus on inland surveys only,
  - recent data/information have been identified by some other sources.

#### Way Forward

- sought assistance from regional neighbors/agencies to carry out hydrographic surveys to update existing old charts,
- providing coherent MSI services and establishing a designated hydrographic authority for maintaining good communication link with PCA and Navarea Coordinator,
- develop minimal capability for hydrographic information gathering,
- participate in bilateral arrangements for production of Kiribati charts,
