The 12<sup>th</sup> SWPHC Conference is being held at the Warwick Le Lagon Resort & Spa Hotel, Port Vila, Vanuatu.

#### How to get to the Warwick Le Lagon Hotel.

Warwick Le Lagon Resort & Spa is 8 kilometers (15 minutes) away from Bauerfield International Airport. Taxis - VT 2700 (\$28 AUD); one way and transfer coaches - VT 2500 (\$26 AUD); return per person if booked in advance through the resort.

#### The Meeting Venue and Accommodation.

November is a very busy time for the hotel so you are <u>strongly</u> advised to make your reservation by **10th July** to ensure the conference rate.

Block Booking Rates:

Garden Superior & Garden View Deluxe – 16,000 VT (\$166 AUD)

Lagon Superior Rooms – 20,000 VT (\$207 AUD) Rates are inclusive of full buffet breakfast. 12% VAT and tourism levy are not included.

### Alternative Accommodation -

Cheaper hotels for delegates are situated approximately 4km from Warwick Le Legon Resort & Spa, and they are the Melanesian Hotel <u>www.melanesianportvila.com</u> and Kaiviti Motel <u>www.kaivitimotel.com</u>. Please check websites for rates. It takes around 8-10 minutes bus ride to the meeting venue. Bus fares cost VT150 (\$1.60 AUD) one way.

#### Will I require a visa?

Depending on your nationality, and the purpose and duration of your visit you may require a visa to visit Vanuatu. If you require assistance or a letter of invitation please contact Sheena Luankon - <u>sluankon@vanuatu.gov.vu</u>

#### What electricity supply is used in Vanuatu?

Electricity in Vanuatu is supplied at 240volts/50Hz. Electrical sockets are of the three flat pin type as found in Australia and New Zealand. If you plan to use your own electrical equipment with different plug configuration and/or voltage rating to Vanuatu, you will require a plug adaptor and possibly a power converter as well. These can be purchased at most duty free shops and some convenience stores and are sometimes available at the reception desk of hotels.

#### Tipping

There are no official tipping rates in Vanuatu. Tourists can tip hospitality industry staff at whatever preferred rate they wish.

#### Can I drink the water?

Water in Vanuatu is considered safe; however, if you prefer bottled water it is readily available.

#### Weather

Vanuatu is renowned for its beautiful subtropical climate with what seems like endless sunshine, clear blue skies and mild temperatures. The summer climate in Vanuatu falls between November and March with average temperatures reaching 28°C. The summer months are hot and humid but are generally well cooled by the sea breezes. November to April is the wet season, with higher temperatures and heavier rains.
